Poland; 2) Richard Crossfield, born in 1868; died 1951, an early businessman, portrayed by Sam Terry; 3) Forrest Ellis Rice, born in 1917, died in 1977; owned an appliance business in Glasgow and built the plane hanging in the museum lobby, portrayed by his son, Chappy Rice; 4) Nathaniel Gorin Terry, a very dynamic early preacher of this area portrayed by descendent Charles Goodman; 5) Mr. Francis Marion Jones, a proprietor of a dry goods store known as the F.M. Jones & Brother Store, portrayed by Todd Steenbergen; and 6) Miss Bess Howard, born in 1890, died in 1975; was a teacher, then became the first women elected as the Barren County Court Clerk, portrayed by Peggy Goodman.
